Grades K-3 *(The museum will be tweaking the programs to accommodate this age range.)*

AM: Explore Egypt. Learn about Ancient Egypt by role-playing archaeologists. Excavate and examine Egyptian artifacts, build a pyramid, and see a real Egyptian mummy.

PM: Discover Vancouver. Explore the Vancouver History Galleries on a guided scavenger hunt. Experience the early years with the first movie of Vancouver, get your hair done in the 1940s, listen to the jukebox in the 1950s, and dress in clothing authentic to the 1960s. Students will work in mixed age teams and with parent support.

Grades 4+ All Day Animating History: The Story of the Mummy Panechates

Work with professional animators to storyboard a plot, create and animate characters, and add dialogue and sound effects. You'll complete a one to two minute animated story by the end of the day. Presented by Reel 2 Real and Museum of Vancouver.
