We have arranged a field trip for students in Grades 6 to 9 on Wednesday, October 9, 2019. We will meet at the Vancouver Police Museum, located at 240 East Cordova Street, Vancouver, at 12:45 pm. The tour will begin at 1:00pm and it is approximately 2 hours long. Each Home Quest student will get to have a tour of the museum as well as participate in a break and enter investigation.

The Vancouver Police Museum and Archives is an independent museum run by the Vancouver Police Historical Society, a registered charity. The Museum's foundations began in celebration of the Vancouver Police Department's centennial anniversary in 1986 and have since expanded beyond the blue lens of local law enforcement to include the history of the Vancouver Coroner's Services and the historic City Analyst Laboratory that houses the Museum.

The class will be supervised by Home Quest staff.
