After your 1.5 hour program led by museum education staff, tour the TD Explore Zone and Being Punjabi: Unfolding the Surrey Story.

We will meet at **9:45 a.m. at the museum** on Thursday, October 10, 2019. The field trip will be supervised by Home Quest staff and parent volunteers. Students should dress for the weather (rain or shine).
