We have arranged a field trip for students in Grades 3 – 5 on **Tuesday, December 10, 2019** from **10:00 am – 12:00 pm** at Anvil Centre in New Westminister. We will meet at Anvil Centre, located at 777 Columbia Street.

Field Trip Description: *This fun and interactive program will educate students on local First Nations people’s technology, trade and relationship with nature in the past and present, as well as the changes that occurred due to colonization. Students will create a piece of artwork using Coast Salish design elements, play games to learn about ecosystems, try traditional foods, and explore First Nations artifacts from 3500 years ago.*
