The GSC is the country's oldest scientific organization and one of Canada's first government organizations. In 1842, the Geological Survey of Canada was formed and William Edmond Logan was appointed as the Survey's first Director on April 14, 1842. Its mandate was to assist in developing a viable Canadian mineral industry by establishing the general geological base on which the industry could plan further detailed investigations. Throughout its long history, the GSC has played a leading role in the exploration of Canada.

We will meet at **10:00 a.m.** on Wednesday, February 12, 2020. The field trip will be supervised by Home Quest staff and parent volunteers. Please bring only small backpacks and a bag lunch. Home Quest pays for each enrolled student and 1 parent per family.
